INTRODUCTION

- 1. "Contribution" means: to give or supply.
 - a. There are some things all of us can give or supply toward the success of the congregation.
- 2. In this lesson, we want to look at these contributions.

I. THE CONTRIBUTION OF ATTITUDE

- a. Attitude is the frame of mind one has toward things.
- b. One cannot be sent to jail for the wrong attitudes.
 - i. But the Lord can send us to Hell for them I John 3:15.
- c. The reason we do the wrong things is because we have the wrong attitude Matt. 5: 28; Mark 7: 20 22; Prov. 4:23; Matt. 12:35.
- d. The attitude of INDIFFERENCE manifests itself; a lack of feeling for or against anything:
 - i. In one failing to attend all the services Heb. 10:25.
 - ii. In failing to support gospel meetings.
 - iii. In failing to teach others the gospel.
 - iv. In failing to study the Bible at home.
 - v. In failing to attend Bible study.
- e. The wrong attitude toward "PLEASURES OF THIS WORLD" 2 Tim. 3:4; I John 2: 15 17:
 - i. They see nothing wrong with the Dance Gal. 5:19.
 - ii. They see nothing wrong with wearing shorts I Tim. 2:9.
 - iii. They see nothing wrong with a social drink Prov. 20:1.
 - iv. They see nothing wrong in what they call a "white lie" Rev. 21:8.
 - v. They see nothing wrong in filthy movies.
 - vi. They see nothing wrong in mixed swimming Gal. 5:19.
- f. The attitude of "SELF-SATISFACTION" Rev. 3:17.
 - i. This attitude says "leave things as they are; don't rock the boat".
 - ii. It says we don't need to do anymore than we are already doing.
 - iii. It says we don't need any preaching; we don't need any improvement.
- g. The "MURMURING OR FAULT-FINDING" attitude I Cor. 10:10; Matt. 7:1 -5; Phil. 2:14; I Pet. 4:9.
 - i. Men found fault with the Lord:
 - 1. Because He ate with the publicans and sinners Matt. 9:11.
 - 2. Christ was criticized because of His family Matt. 13:55.
 - 3. He was chided because of the community in which He lived John 1:46.
 - 4. He and John the Baptist were both criticized Luke 7: 33- 34.
 - ii. Paul was criticized:

- Men said, "His bodily presence is weak, and his speech contemptible" 2 Cor. 10:10.
- 2. They said he was a "babbler" Acts 17: 18.
- 3. I Cor. 4:3.
- II. THE CONTRIBUTION OF SERVICE
 - a. The Lord saves men and women to SERVE HIM I Cor. 6:20; 15:58.
 - b. All have some ability Matt. 25: 14 15.
 - c. All do not have the same ability Rom. 12: 4 8.
 - d. We must render to Him service DAILY:
 - i. We are to pray daily I Thess. 5:17
 - ii. We are to study daily 2 Tim. 2:15
 - iii. We are to teach daily I Pet. 3:15
 - iv. We are to encourage one another daily Heb. 10: 24
