First Century Preaching Needed Today

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LESSON ONE

INTRODUCTION

- 1. It pleased God to save the human family by preaching the Gospel 1 Cor. 1:21; Mk. 16:15 16.
- 2. Jesus sent the Apostles into ALL the WORLD to preach the gospel Mk. 16:15 16; Matt. 28:19 20.
- 3. Paul charged Timothy to preach the Word -- 2 Tim. 4:2; I Pet. 4:11; Isa. 8:20.
- 4. God had but one Son and He was a preacher Matt. 4:17.
- 5. If we accomplish today what God wants accomplished by preaching we will have to preach as first century preachers preached.
- 6. Let us look at First Century Preaching:

I. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING WAS WORLD-TURNING PREACHING

- a. The presence of Paul and his companions was felt as they would enter a city to preach Acts 16:20.
- b. The Jews in Thessalonica said, "These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also" Acts 17:6.
- c. Preaching that "turns the world upside down" is Bible centered preaching.
 - i. Peter on Pentecost Acts 2: 14 40.
 - ii. Stephen Acts 7.
 - iii. Philip Acts 8:12; Acts 8:35.
- d. Many Preachers do not give the plan of Salvation today Luke 24: 47; Acts 2:38.
- II. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING WAS "CUT TO THE HEART" PREACHING.
 - a. Stephen's preaching "cut to the heart" Acts 7: 54.
 - b. Peter's preaching pricked in their heart Acts 2:37.
 - c. The Word of God is "sharper than any two-edged sword" Heb. 4:12.
 - d. First century preaching convicted men of sin John 16:8.
 - e. Preaching that does not cause men's conscience to hurt is NOT first century preaching.
- III. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING WAS BOLD PREACHING.
 - a. Paul was a bold preacher Eph. 6: 18 20.
 - b. I Thess. 2:2; Acts 9: 27.
 - c. A preacher needs to open his mouth and speak out boldly so that those who hear will not misunderstand what has been said.
- IV. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING CAUSED MEN TO TREMBLE
 - a. Paul's preaching caused Felix to tremble Acts 24: 24 25.
 - b. If we will preach like Paul, it will cause men to tremble today.
- V. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING HAD SOME LIFE IN IT.
 - a. Peter "lifted up his voice" Acts 2:14.
 - b. God said to Ezekiel, "Smite with thine hand, and stamp with thy foot, and say . . . " Ezek. 6:11.
 - c. Too much preaching today is lifeless.

- VI. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING WAS UNCOMPROMISING.
 - a. Paul did not compromise with error Gal. 2:5.
 - b. Paul taught Titus NOT to put in compromising elders Tit. 1: 9 14.
 - c. John was uncompromising -2 John 9-11.
 - d. Paul was uncompromising on morals I Cor. 5: 1-5; 5:11.
 - e. Too much compromising is found in preaching today.
- VII. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING DEMANDED SOME SOUL SEARCHING
 - a. Paul said, "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith" -2 Cor. 13:5.
 - b. Preaching that does not cause us to examine ourselves will not do us any good.
- VIII. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING WAS "IN SEASON AND OUT OF SEASON" PREACHING.
 - a. Paul told Timothy, "Preach the word; be instant in season and out of season" . . . —2 Tim. 4:2.
 - b. There is NEVER A TIME when a preacher can let up in his preaching 2 Tim. 4:5.
 - c. We must preach it when people like it and when they don't like it.
- IX. CONCLUSION

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LESSON TWO

- I. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING LEADS SINNERS TO SEE THAT THERE IS A GOD TO GLORIFY.
 - a. Paul said God is to be glorified in the church Eph. 3:21.
 - b. Paul said "Whatsoever ye do, do all in the glory of God" I Cor. 10: 31.
 - c. Peter said we are to glorify God in the name "Christian" I Pet. 4:16.
 - d. Paul said we are to glorify God in our body and spirit I Cor. 6:20.
- II. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING LED MEN TO SEE THERE IS A SAVIOR TO IMITATE.
 - a. Paul said, "Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ" I Cor. 11:1.
 - b. Peter said, "Ye should follow His steps"—I Pet. 2:21.
 - c. Jesus said we are to follow Him Matt. 16:24; Luke 9:23
 - d. John said we are to walk as He WALKED I John 2:6; Gal. 2:20; Eph. 3:17.
- III. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING CAUSED SINNERS TO SEE THEY HAD A SOUL TO SAVE
 - a. Peter said, "Save yourselves from this untoward generation" Acts 2:40.
 - b. Paul I Tim. 2:4
 - c. 2 Pet. 3:9
 - d. 2 Cor. 6:2
 - e. Acts 2: 37 38
 - f. Acts 8: 35 39
 - g. Matt. 16:26
 - h. Luke 19:10
 - i. Rom. 3:23
- IV. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING IMPRESSED UPON PEOPLE'S MINDS THAT THERE IS EVIL TO BE SHUNNED.
 - a. Paul said, "Abstain from all appearance of evil" I Thess. 5:22.
 - b. John said, "Love not the world" –I John 2: 15 17.
 - c. Paul listed the works of the flesh Gal. 5: 19 21;
 - d. Peter I Pet. 2:11.
- V. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING TAUGHT CHRISTIANS TO DEFEND THE TRUTH
 - a. Jude 3
 - b. Phil. 1:17
 - c. Eph. 6: 10 -17
 - d. I Tim. 1:18; I Tim. 6:20.
- VI. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING TAUGHT CHRISTIANS:
 - a. That the work of the church was to be supported with their money I Cor. 16; 1 2; 2 Cor. 9: 6-7.
 - b. That they were to work to the full capacity of their talents I Cor. 15:58; Heb. 6:10.
 - c. They were to attend the assemblies of worship Heb. 10:25.
- VII. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING BROUGHT MEN TO FACE THE FACT THEY MUST DIE.
 - a. Heb. 9:27
 - b. 2 Tim. 4: 6 8
 - c. James 4: 13 16

- VIII. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING IMPRESSED UPON MEN THEY WOULD STAND IN THE JUDGMENT OF GOD.
 - a. Acts 17:21

 - c. Heb. 9: 27
 - d. Rev. 20: 12 15
- IX. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING CAUSED MEN TO REALIZE THEY MUST SPEND ETERNITY IN HEAVEN OR HELL.
 - a. The saved will go to <u>heaven</u>:
 - i. I Thess. 4: 15 18
 - ii. I Cor. 15: 50 58
 - iii. John 14: 1 3
 - b. The lost will go to hell:
 - i. 2 Thess. 1: 7 9
 - ii. Matt. 25: 46, 41
- X. CONCLUSION
 - a. Preaching that does not have these marks is NOT First Century Preaching.
 - b. Are you here and have never obeyed the gospel?

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LESSON THREE

PREACHING THAT WILL CONVICT THE WORLD OF SIN

- I. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING EMPHASIZED THE MESSAGE AND NOT THE MESSENGER
 - a. Gospel preaching was NOT committed to angels, but to MEN.
 - i. The gospel was first preached by and in inspired men -2 Cor. 4:7; Rom. 10:13-17.
 - ii. The apostles were to carry the gospel into all the world Matt. 28: 19 20; Mk. 16:15 16
 - iii. The gospel is to be continually committed to men who are to preach it -2 Tim. 2:2.
 - b. God wants NOTHING TO HINDER the message.
 - i. Paul said, "For we preach not ourselves; but Christ Jesus the Lord" 2 Cor. 4:5.
 - ii. Paul said, "for I determined not to know anything among you, save Jesus Christ, and Him crucified" –I Cor. 2:2.
 - iii. Paul said, "But we preach Christ crucified" I Cor. 1: 23.
 - iv. He said he preached the gospel I Cor. 15:1 4.
 - v. Philip preached Christ to the people of Samaria Acts 8:5, 12.
 - vi. He preached Jesus to the Eunuch Acts 8: 35.
 - c. Paul tells who the MESSENGERS are:
 - i. They are MINISTERS I Cor. 3:5.
 - ii. They are SERVANTS 2 Cor. 4:5; Gal. 1:10.
 - iii. They do the work of an EVANGELIST; He is to proclaim glad tidings; the gospel 2 Tim. 4:5.
 - d. Paul PREACHED because he HAD to I Cor. 9:16.
 - i. Men need to do the same today.
- II. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING DEALT WITH SIN AS A REALITY
 - a. Paul dealt with sin as an AWFUL REALITY.
 - i. He said by one man sin entered into the world Rom. 5:12.
 - ii. He said both Jews and Gentiles are all under $\sin \text{Rom. } 3:9-10.$
 - iii. He said all have sinned Rom. 3:23.
 - iv. He said the wages of sin is death Rom. 6:23.
 - b. John dealt with sin as a REALITY:
 - i. I John 1: 8 10
 - ii. I John 3:4
 - iii. Rev. 1:5
 - c. Peter dealt with sin as a REALITY:
 - i. 2 Pet. 2: 1-9
 - ii. I Pet. 3:18
 - iii. I Pet. 3:21
- III. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING DEALT WITH SIN IN PARTICULAR IT WAS SPECIFIC.
 - a. Peter on Pentecost Acts 2: 22 -23
 - b. Stephen before the Council Acts 7: 51 54

- c. Paul before Felix Acts 24: 24 25.
- d. Paul to the Ephesian Elders Acts 20: 28 30.
- IV. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING SET FORTH THE CONSEQUENCES OF SIN
 - a. Paul to the Romans Rom. 1:32
 - b. Paul to the Corinthians I Cor. 6: 9 10
 - c. Paul to the Galatians Gal. 5: 19 21
- V. FIRST CENTURY PREACHING WAS "FIGHTING" PREACHING
 - a. Paul charged Timothy:
 - i. "Fight the good fight of faith" I Tim. 6:12
 - ii. "War a good warfare" I Tim. 1: 18
 - iii. He told him to be a "good soldier" I Tim. 2:3
 - b. Paul said "I fought a good fight" 2 Tim. 4:7
 - c. We are to put on the "whole armor of God" Eph. 6: 11 -17.
 - d. 2 Cor. 10: 3 8
 - e. Gospel Preachers are to reprove and rebuke $\sin 2$ Tim. 4: 2 5.
 - f. First Century Preachers fought sins in the lives of men and women.

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
