- **a.** They are to be faithful in ATTITUDE.
  - i. Right attitude toward the authority of Christ Matt. 28:18; Eph. 1: 22 23; I Pet. 3:22; I Pet. 4: 11.
    - 1. The line must be drawn sharply between truth and error Gal. 2:5.
  - **ii.** Right attitude toward men who preach the truth Gal. 4:16; Tit. 1: 9 11.
  - iii. Right attitude toward members Heb. 13:1; John 13: 34 35.
  - iv. Right attitude toward preaching to the Lost Mk. 16: 15 16.
- **b.** They are to be faithful in putting the Kingdom FIRST Matt. 6:33.
  - **i.** Put it before self Luke 9:23.
  - ii. Must come before loved ones Matt. 10:37.
  - iii. Must come before the dead Matt. 8: 21 22.
  - **iv.** Must come before pleasure 2 Tim. 3:4.
- **c.** They are to be faithful in **BIBLE STUDY**.
  - **i.** 2 Tim. 2:15
  - **ii.** Heb. 5: 12 14
  - **iii.** They attend Bible Study classes.
- **d.** They are to be faithful in LIFE.
  - **i.** 2 Cor. 6: 14 17; Rom. 12:1 2; Tit. 2: 11 -12.

- e. They are to be faithful in PRAYER.
